Stakeholders in a project are usually divided into secondary and primary stakeholders. Primary stakeholders are the main decision makers who actively participate in a project and have great influence over its outcomes. Secondary stakeholders may attend meetings or play an insignificant role in the project however they don't have much influence.

There are several different types of project-management methods. Agile and lean approaches are among the most popular. Heuristics, critical chain project management, as well as agile and lean approaches are also very popular. The PRINCE2 methodology is a good example of a systematic project management method. It divides the project in seven steps: Leading the Project, Beginning a Project, Initiating the Project, Managing Product Boundaries, Controlling a Stage and Managing Product Delivery, and closing a project.
